## Questions to the Federal Candidates

1. School choice initiatives such as tuition tax credits or vouchers.
2. Increase the Federal income tax rates.
3. The U.S. Supreme Court's 1973 Roe v. Wade abortion decision.
4. Federal Defense of Marriage Act (DOMA), federal law that defines marriage as between one man and one woman.
5. Public funding of research using human embryos.
6. Appointing only strict constructionist judges.
7. Require notice be given to a parent before an abortion is performed on a minor.
8. A nationwide, government regulated health care system that guarantees health care for every American at taxpayer expense.
9. Additional regulations for firearms or firearm sales.
10. Religious Freedom Restoration Act (RFRA), passed by Congress in 1993.

## Questions to State Candidates

1. School choice initiatives such as tuition tax credits or vouchers.
2. Requiring voter approval for increasing income taxes or income tax rates for individuals or corporations.
3. Legislation prohibiting partial birth abortions.
4. Extend homosexual couples the legal benefits and privileges that the state currently provides to married couples.
5. Public funding of research using human embryos.
6. Appointing only strict constructionist judges.
7. Require notice be given to a parent before an abortion is performed on a minor.
8. A nationwide, government regulated health care system that guarantees health care for every American at taxpayer expense.
9. Additional regulations for firearms or firearm sales.
